Stranger Danger Goes Online

For kids — read this together with a grown-up.

A stranger online is a stranger in real life. The same rules you use at the playground work online too.

FOUR THINGS TO NEVER DO WITH ONLINE STRANGERS

- 1 Never share where you are**
Don't tell an online stranger where you live or where you go to school.
- 2 Never send pictures**
No selfies, no videos, no pictures of your house. If they ask, the answer is no — then tell a grown-up.
- 3 Never agree to meet**
Not at the park, not at a store, not anywhere. If someone online asks to meet, tell a grown-up right away.
- 4 Never keep strangers secret**
If an online stranger asks you to keep them a secret from your grown-ups, that's exactly when you tell.

IF YOU TAKE ONE THING FROM THIS LESSON

Tell the grown-up watching with you who you usually talk to in your games and apps. Just naming them out loud is the whole lesson.
